Level C requires: A valid New York State license as a Professional Engineer and six years of full-time, paid post-licensure experience as a Professional Engineer; three years must be as a project engineer; project, team, or squad leader. Salary range: \$79,611.00 - \$129,350.00 Annually

Current New York State Professional Engineer license must be maintained for the duration of employment for all levels.
