

Industrial Engineering - College of the Ozarks invites applications for a full-time faculty position in industrial engineering and related topics. Preference will be given to candidates who hold a Ph.D. and have a P.E. license with industry experience. Rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
