Submit nominations via the [ASEM Online Nomination Form](#) by June 30 for the following awards. Please note that some awards require that you send in additional information as well.

Bernard R. Sarchet Award: This is considered to be the highest award given by ASEM. This award recognizes contributions to the Society and to the field of engineering management.

Frank Woodbury Special Service Award: This award recognizes an ASEM member who has provided outstanding service to the Society.

Meritorious Service Award: These awards were created to recognize the effort of the local sections of ASEM. Four awards exist and include:

1. New Member Recruiting
2. Outstanding Non-Board Member
3. Outstanding Local Section President
4. Outstanding Student Chapter President

Founder's Award – Undergraduate: This award recognizes an undergraduate engineering management program leadership.

Founder's Award – Graduate: This award recognizes a graduate engineering management program leadership.


